

## **Axsun Technologies Position on Conflict Minerals**

Axsun Technologies is committed to promoting social responsibility and environmental sustainability around the world. Although Axsun is a privately held company, and as such, not required to file a Conflict Minerals report as defined in the provisions of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, HR 4173, Section 1502 ("Conflict Minerals Act"), we work with our suppliers to confirm that their supplies of materials do not contain metals derived from conflict minerals that directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or adjoining countries.

Axsun Technologies does not knowingly purchase raw material supplies that contain conflict minerals that directly or indirectly finance or benefit armed groups in the DRC or an adjoining country. Due to the complexity of the routes by which metals, and in particular precious metals, are smelted, recycled and sold, including the common practice of commingling ores and scrap from many different sources, it is often impossible for any company to obtain full traceability to an exact origin of all. However, we take continuous practical actions to seek to ensure that minerals from the conflict region do not enter our supply chain including obtaining certificates of origin.
